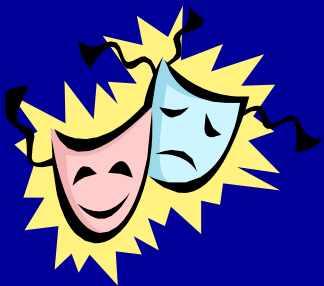


Monhagen Middle School After School Clubs

- **Science Club** – In Science Club, 6th graders have the opportunity to explore some of the many different areas of science. The club is designed to give its members the chance to learn through activities that will enhance their understanding and appreciation of science. Mondays from 2:15PM-3:25PM in Room 106).
- **Art Club** – Enjoy a day after school expressing yourself through art. Drawing, painting, set design, clay, and paper mache.
- **Kiwanis Builders Club** – Students participate in a variety of community service activities in conjunction with the Middletown Schools as well as the community benefit.
- **Technology Club** – The Technology Club is open to all grade levels. The club is designed for students to have fun creating hands on projects to enhance their motor skills, problem solving skills, and knowledge of the use of tools.
- **Computer Workshop** – Students are given the opportunity to do additional work on their classroom assignments. Each student will log on to our website www.yearbookavenue.com with a user name and be responsible for a section of the yearbook. Yearbook meets once a week from 2:15PM-3:30PM.
- **Jazz Band** – Jazz band provides an extra performing opportunity for Monhagen’s instrumental music students in Grades 6-8. Students in this group learn to perform in various styles of jazz as well as some of the basics of jazz improvisation. The jazz band performs at our March Pops Concert and May Spring Concert. We also provide entertainment at district events including the MMS Book Fair and the Middletown Arts Festival. Director Michael Kochem and Co-Director Ryan Carlozzi meet for rehearsal on Wednesday afternoons from October through end of May.
- **Newspaper Club** – This club is responsible for creating a newspaper that lets parents and students know what is going on at Monhagen. The club allows members to use their talents in writing to express their thoughts and ideas in a creative and innovative way. Members also learn how to edit and learn the proper way of formatting a newspaper.
- **Latin Percussion Club** – The Latin Percussion Club is designed to introduce students to African based music. Various rhythms are learned with a focus on “clave,” which is the basis of instruments within different genres.
- **Chess Club** – Chess! Synonymous with Olympics of the Mind! Students learn how to play a mental sport that they can develop the rest of their lives. Strategies, patience and good sportsmanship are a few of the skills developed in this club. Students participate in tournaments throughout the year.
